I know this sounds silly...however, it is VERY important that you follow this list as it makes for a much smoother year...it's all about organization!

- One- 1 1/2 inch three ring notebook (pockets in front and back) for agenda
(**sturdy- and no bigger than 1 1/2 inch as the agenda pages will not turn freely**)
- 2 composition notebooks-they have a marble looking cover...**not spiral notebooks**
- 3 inexpensive pocket folders- (**no prongs..plain, regular size, different colors**)
- 1 **plastic** inexpensive pocket folder
- 1 pack of notebook paper- **wide ruled**
- 1 pack of plain white copy paper
- 2 packs of pencils- **no mechanical pencils please**
- 1 bottle of glue (**regular size please**)
- 1 box of crayons (24 count **only** please, nothing bigger!)
- 1 box of Kleenex-we will need a **second box** in January
- 1 box of Ziplock **freezer** bags (girl's bring quart size; boy's bring gallon size)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack of Black Expo dry erase markers- **chisel tip** (low odor please)
- 1 **large zipper** pencil bag- **no hard plastic pencil boxes please!**
- 1 **set of headphones** -We go every week to the computer lab, so we must have these! (They can be bought at the school store and they are guaranteed!!)
